What Can Sam's Club Donate?

- # 76- **Fresh Meat** (Cut Meat, Cryovacs, processed beef, chicken, pork, lamb, etc.)
- # 72- **Expanded Deli** (Dips, gourmet cheeses)
- # 93- **Branded Deli** (Sausage, hams, bacon, etc.)
- # 77- **Fresh Bakery** (rolls, breads, cakes prepared in-store)
- # 48- **Processed Bakery** (packaged product produced elsewhere)
- *****Frozen Pizzas and HMS meals CAN be donated**

Note: *Only items within the above category types are authorized. Due to food safety concerns, rotisserie items and seafood items are excluded from donations.*

Sam's Club Procedures

- Product should be pulled from the floor on or before its expiration date.
- All product should be boxed and scanned to donation using the Telxon donation procedures, thereby creating a donation batch.
- All product should be placed in the freezer, to freeze overnight, or until the time of pickup.
- Second Harvest Heartland will collect on a scheduled delivery route at least twice per week.
