Eligibility & Funding Use



2023 Capacity Building Grant

The Second Harvest Heartland 2023 Capacity Building Grant will support program and operational capacity building projects that increase or improve food access in local communities.

For the purposes of this grant, capacity building is defined as growth or expansion to serve more people in the community, make services more accessible, and improve and streamline operations.



Who can apply for this grant?



- Applicants must be a Second Harvest Heartland Agency Partner operating in compliance with the terms in the active 2022-2024 Second Harvest Heartland Agency Partnership Agreement.
- Programs and services must be located in Minnesota counties in Second Harvest Heartland's service area



Goal of the grant



The goal of this grant is to increase programmatic and organizational capacity in the hunger-relief system.

Projects or programs should reflect new growth and or specific changes as a result of this grant.



Examples of programmatic or operational growth



- Expand physical capacity
 - New food distribution site
 - Increase food storage capacity
- Improve physical site for increased food delivery or client access
- Add programs or increase food distribution capacity
- Increase organizational and operational capacity
 - Personnel
 - Interns
 - Volunteers



What can the grant be used for?

Capacity building funds can be used for, but not limited to :

- Equipment purchases and installation
- Building improvements
- Operational expenses for new or expanding programs or services
- Personnel-associated expenses for new or expanding programs
- Client access improvements
- Expanding or starting client transportation
- New or significant expansion of food rescue or meal delivery
- Food purchases for new or significant expansion of food distribution



What are ineligible grant expenses?

- Reimbursement for expenses incurred prior to the grant period
- Expenses that are reimbursable through other funding sources
- Loan payments or overdue bills
- Food purchases for budgeted or current programs



Funding range



This is a competitive grant. Total distribution funding for the Second Harvest Heartland 2023 Capacity Building Grant is \$475,000.

Second Harvest Heartland expects most grant awards to fall between \$10,000 and \$50,000.

Grant requests are not required to be within this range. Please request the amount that is needed for your project or purpose.

Second Harvest Heartland will consider partial funding if unable to provide full funding for this grant.

What is required in the application?



- Organization Information
 - Contact Information
- Organizational Overview (text boxes contain word limits)
 - Mission and History
 - Community and Neighbors
 - Program and Services



What is required in the application?



- Capacity Building Project Information
 - Project Title
 - Request Summary (2-3 sentences)
 - Driving Need (why?)
 - Project Development (who determined the need?)
 - Project Activities (what and how will capacity be built?)
 - Impact and Outcome (what growth is expected?)



What is required in the application?



- Capacity Building Project Information (continued)
 - Access for Underserved Communities? (specify)
 - Responsible Parties (who will carry out the work/oversee?)
 - Partners (optional, may not apply to all applications)
 - Sustainability (optional, may not apply to all applications)



Budget information



Applicants can use their own project budget, or the template found on [Agency Zone](#).

- Budget Attachment
- Total Project Budget
- Grant Request Amount
- Other Funding Sources (optional, may not apply to all applications)
- Budget Narrative (optional, may not apply to all applications)



2023 Capacity Building Grant

Review Process

What is taken into consideration?



Reviews will consider multiple aspects, including, but not limited to:

- Eligibility of funding use
- The projected impact or outcomes of the proposed project or purpose
- Priority will be considered for underserved or under-resourced organizations,
- Priority will be considered for Agency Partners who have not received a Second Harvest Heartland grant in 2023 (not including the 2023 Unrestricted Grant)
